Greetings Faithful Disciples of Jesus,

We had a wonderful Holy Week with great participation in each of our services. Maundy Thursday - I want to thank everyone who attended, as well as all of you who took part in the foot washing. Good Friday - we had great attendance with about 75 people coming and being part of that powerful service. Easter was fantastic with the church being full; the Easter Egg Hunt in between services was wonderful, and the music at both services was fantastic. Faithful disciples, it was great and it was great because of each of you.



I am excited because we continue to move forward because of your commitment to St. Mark's. As you know, we are currently working on raising the money we need to complete the Atrium project. Here is a brief update: I've met with Popham construction and the building inspector. At this time we've not turned up any red flags to keep us from moving forward. Once we say yes to Popham construction, it will take about one month to complete the necessary steps with the state of Indiana and then about three months to complete the project. In order to tell Popham to move forward we will need to collect 75% of the \$87,000, which is \$65,000. Right now, we have commitments of \$37,000 and we have collected \$12,000.

Very soon you will see a new parking lot and that will be awesome. The first thing a visitor sees is the outside of our building, so it is vital for us to make sure we keep God's house looking great on the inside and outside. The parking lot will certainly impact the outside and we've been blessed with a couple of good custodians helping us keep the inside of the building looking good.

Friends we are blessed. We continue to fulfill God's mission here at St. Mark's and it shows in all that we have and continue to accomplish together. Things are happening and we just need to trust God and remain faithful.

Together, let us continue to help people find and follow Jesus Christ. Please invite a friend to come to church with you.
