


THE GRAPEVINE




CPR/First Aid Certification Class



Life Line Screening

Life Line Screening, a leading provider of community-based preventive health screenings, is pleased to offer a preventive health event at St Mark's Lutheran Church on **August 9, 2017.** Five screenings will be offered that scan for potential health problems related to: 1. **blocked arteries** which is a leading cause of stroke; 2. **abdominal aortic aneurysms** which can lead to a ruptured aorta; 3. **hardening of the arteries in the legs** which is a strong predictor of heart disease; 4. **atrial fibrillation or irregular heart beat** which is closely tied to stroke risk; and 5. a **bone density screening**, for men and women, used to assess the risk of osteoporosis.

Date: Saturday, October 28, 2017


Time: 3:00 pm. Worship followed by a reception
